SUFFIXES [Forming Parts of Speech]

When you are reading, you will come across unfamiliar words. It is often possible to guess their meanings if you understand the way words in English are generally formed. An English word can be divided into three parts: a **prefix**, a **[root / base word]**, and a **SUFFIX**. **Pre-** means 'before'. A **prefix**, therefore, is what comes before the **[root / base word]**. A **SUFFIX** is attached to the end of the **[root / base word]**. Many times, a word can be defined when it is known what the **prefix** and the **SUFFIX** mean. **Prefixes** usually change the meaning of the word. **However, a SUFFIX can change the meaning of the word; it can also form the part of speech.** Below are groups of **SUFFIXES (Multiple SUFFIXES)** that are all used in the **Academic Vocabulary List**. **They are listed under the parts of speech they form.** The bolded **SUFFIXES** are usually seen more often.

The AWL is a list of words which appear with high frequency in English-language academic texts: texts, journals, courses, laboratory manuals, etc. The list was compiled by Averil Coxhead at the Victoria University of Wellington, New Zealand.

The list contains 570 word families and is divided into 10 sublists. Sublist 1 consists of the 60 most common words in the AWL. Sublist 2 contains the next most frequently used words and so on. Each sublist contains 60 word families, except for sublist 10, which contains 30.

These are all words that anyone planning to attend university in a Western country should know.

Sublists of the Academic Word List

Each word in italics is the most frequently occurring member of the word family in the Academic Corpus. For example, *analysis* is the most common form of the word family analyse. British and American spelling is included in the word families, so contextualise and contextualize are both included in the family *context*.
